How the clinic works:

Trained instructors provide hands-on, in-car training that consists of 4 hours of classroom, 4 hours of on-course driving exercises, and a reference manual for home study.

In-car exercises include:

- Emergency braking techniques
- Slalom course to demonstrate weight transfer of the vehicle
- Car handling during wet road conditions using a skid pad
- Sudden lane changes simulating accident avoidance
- A final road course that combines elements from each previous exercise
